







WHAT IS RABIES?

- 1. Rabies is a dangerous disease, caused by a virus;
- 2. Rabies kills 50,000 people and millions of animals each year around the world;
- 3. Any mammal can be infected by Rabies: dogs, cats, cattle, sheep, wild animals and also humans.

PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS:

- 1. Never touch a stray or wild animal;
- 2. Always ask permission to touch someone's pet;
- Tell your parents if you see a wild or stray animal acting strange.



PROTECT YOURSELF AND YOUR PETS:

- 1. Humans and animals are infected by Rabies if they are bitten or scratched by animal with Rabies:
- 2. Rabies is transmitted with saliva of sick animal.



HOW TO PROTECT ANIMAL FROM RABIES?

- 1. Vaccinate your pets;
- 2. keep your animal away from stray animals;
- 3. Avoid contact with wild animal.

HOW TO PROTECT HUMAN FROM RABIES?

- 1. If you are bitten or scratched by animal tell your parents immediately;
- 2. Wash the wound out with soap and water;
- 3. Call your doctor right away.
